Below are some helpful hints for the paying our Anchorage HOA dues;

The Anchorage HOA annual maintenance dues are due January 1st of each year.

- Annual fee is \$400.00. If dues are not received by the January 18, a late notice will be sent with a \$25.00 delinquent fee charge.
- Semi-annual fees are \$200.00 and due January 1 and July 1. If dues are not received by the 18th for the semi-annual period, a late notice will be sent with \$25.00 delinquent fee charge.
- Quarterly fees are \$100.00 and due January 1, April 1, July 1, and October 1. If dues are not received by the 18th of each quarter, a late notice will be sent with \$25.00 delinquent fee charge.
- We do not accept cash for HOA dues.
- The HOA does not send invoices or reminder letters.

An option to mailing your personal check or money order, is to setup Anchorage HOA in bill pay through your bank to pay your dues, whether annual, semi-annual, or quarterly. If adding Anchorage HOA as a Payee, make sure you put your name, address, and what you are paying, such as 2022 Annual HOA Dues, in the memo line

Checks, money orders, or bank checks shall be made payable to Anchorage Homeowners' Association. Payment may be mailed to or dropped in the lockbox at the clubhouse at, 1025 Anchorage Lane, Palm Harbor, FL 34685.
