UNLICENSED CONTRACTORS

In light of the fact that some of us have been "duped" by unlicensed contractors, below is information that may be helpful to ensure that others will not fall victim to their tactics.

Note: Check the HOA's rules & regulations to ascertain if you need approval prior to commencement of your planned project(s). And, regardless if a neighbor recommends a contractor for the work being planned, do your homework first. It's better to be safe than sorry.

Beware of unlicensed contractors:

Anyone who asks you to obtain the building permit as an "owner/builder".

You will save money by not obtaining a permit.

They want money up front before the job is completed.

These are RED FLAGS indicating they are most likely not licensed.

Unlicensed contractors do not have insurance coverage. Any injury that occurs on your property will be a claim against your insurance.

Tips on selecting a contractor:

Ask to see their license and call the appropriate licensing agency - Pinellas County Construction Licensing Board PCCLB at 472-4163 for verification.

Ask for and verify references from past customers.

Obtain a written estimate from several licensed contractors.

If the work to be done involves damage repairs, check with your insurance agency first to verify that your insurance will cover the repairs before you hire a contractor.

After you choose a contractor:

Make sure your contractor obtains a permit and posts it on the front of the property.

Make sure your contractor provides you with releases of liens from his subcontractors and suppliers.

Before signing a contract, be certain your contract includes:

The contractors name, street address, telephone number and state or local license number.

A precise description of the work to be completed, including a drawing and list of materials.

Completion date, including cleanup after work is finished.

Warranty agreements, including length, terms, and recourse.
