If your address ends in an even number your <u>only</u> day is <u>Saturday</u>.

Please be advised that your first offense is a warning, your second offense will cost you \$193.00. So, adjust your sprinkler systems to reflect this change.

Holiday Greetings to All!

On the morning following the annual meeting, I met with the 5/3 Bank Manager and cashed in our initial 10 CD accounts. In just 5 months, we earned \$ 2,066.70

I put the interest into our checking account, and then, reinvested the original \$ 100,000 plus an additional \$ 30,000 for a total of \$ 130,000 at 5.2% interest for 7 months. The new CD accounts will mature on 5/17/24.
